<p>The Trauma Nurse Core Curriculum is a 2-day standardized course providing the learner with core-level trauma knowledge and psychomotor skills associated with implementing the trauma nursing process. The trauma nursing process is used to standardize the approach to trauma care and is reflected throughout the course and manual. The TNCC teaches a systematic approach for the care of the injured patient.</p> <p>Trauma nursing as a discipline refers to the process and content of all the different roles nurses have in the care of the trauma patient.
