

# Appearance and Dress Code Guidelines

## Personal Appearance

## Guidelines

- ◆ Clothing and appearance are neat and clean
- ◆ School uniform as appropriate for clinicals with student badge visible and worn above the waist level
- ◆ Clothing should be in good repair and should not be **too tight, revealing** or **too baggy**
- ◆ Inappropriate clothing includes:

**Spandex stretch tight pants**

**Jeans**

**Shorts**

**Capri pants**

**Mini Skirts**

**Tank or sleeveless tops**

**Revealing shirts**

**Sheer or see through fabrics**

**Shirts that do not cover midsection**

**Shirts should not have logos or written information**

**Opened toed shoes**

- ◆ Shoes should have low heels, non skid soles and should not make excessive noise while walking through the halls
- ◆ Practice good personal grooming and hygiene
- ◆ Cologne, perfume or aftershave should not be worn
- ◆ Keep hair neat clean and safely secured
